The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, October 20, 2014. Chairman Scott E. Givens called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with three members present: Givens, Brian K. Hauptert and Barry J. Eppley. The proceedings of the meeting were recorded by Wabash County Deputy Auditor Marcie Shepherd. The minutes of the October 14, 2014 meeting were reviewed. Hauptert made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Eppley seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

John Martin, County Highway Superintendent provided an update on Bridge 24, the approaches were poured last Thursday.

Sheriff Bob Land reported the Wabash County Jail currently has 81 inmates with 19 inmates at the Miami County Jail. Last week, there were 5 transports and 9 bookings. The peak population was 84.
