The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, April 6, 2015. Chairman Brian K. Hauptert called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with two commissioners present: Hauptert and Scott E. Givens. The proceedings were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Linda Conrad. The minutes of the March 30, 2015 meeting were reviewed. Givens made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Hauptert seconded the motion; it passed by a 2-0 vote.

Phil Adams, County Highway Supervisor was present with nothing to report.

Wabash County Sheriff Bob Land reported that the Wabash County Jail currently has 76 inmates with 33 inmates housed at the Miami County Jail. There were 10 transports.

Keith Walters, County EMA Director was present with nothing to report.

Steve Downs, County Attorney was present with nothing to report.

Wabash County Auditor Linda Conrad presented:

Elaine Martin, Wabash County Clerk of the Courts requested signatures for the designation of five vote center locations for the elections on Tuesday, May 5. The locations are: First United Methodist Church (Wabash), Wellbrooke of Wabash, Zion Lutheran Church (Wabash), Liberty Township Fire Department, and North Manchester Public Safety Building. Early voting may be performed in the Clerk's office during the two weeks before the election and on Saturday, April 20th and Saturday, May 1. Two additional satellite locations will also be open on both Saturday dates.
