Commissioner Chairman, Lester Templin, called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. in the Commissioners Conference Room of the courthouse, with all members present. Minutes of the 3/19 meeting were approved as written, moved by Brian Hauptert, second by Darle Dawes. and passed. Commissioners reviewed the Jail/Memorial Hall custodian hours. Darle moved to approve the contract between the county and Purdue University for our share (\$31,800.) of extension educators wages for 2001, second by Brian, and passed. Commissioners and their attorney, Tom Mattern, discussed a claim from former judicial building architect, Prince/ Alexander (P/A), and will compile a claim for P/A, listing their errors and omissions, in response. The Bricklayers local # 4, thru their attorney, have filed claims for wages due from Minnick Construction. Tom says the county wants to stay on good terms with the bonding company in this matter. Commissioners told Probation Chief, Tina Edwards, because of the project manager change, there is no progress in plans to remodel Memorial Hall for her department. Brian asked Larry to check debris left from work at the Market Street bridge in No. Manchester. A neighbor has complained, and Larry may have to get Hank's Construction back there to do more clean-up. With no further business, the meeting adjourned.
