Commissioner Chairman, Lester Templin, called the meeting to order with all members present. Minutes of the 8/6 meeting were approved as written, moved by Darle Dawes, second by Les, and passed. Commissioners reviewed a letter from the State Dept. of Health, indicating the county has been awarded \$12,413. for 7/01 thru 6/02/02, from the tobacco settlement funds in the Local Health Maintenance Fund. It will be used for hepatitis serum for high school seniors. They also noted the CAGIT distribution for 2002 will be \$5,385,225. and the CEDIT share will be \$1,452,557. Les and Auditor, Carol Stefanatos, signed the \$5,900. grant award for placing STOP signs at rural railroad crossings, in 2002. Commissioners reviewed the Jail/Memorial Hall custodian hours. After visiting the Walnut Street vacation site in Isaac Kellers Addition of Richvalley, Brian moved to deny the Charles Hunt petition to vacate the street, as it would potentially landlock a lot owned by Dorothea Biehl, second by Darle, and passed. Commissioners will direct highway supervisor, Larry Rice, to place gravel on the unimproved street, so it may be used by both adjacent parties. Darle said he contacted United Acquisitions Services, and learned they are no longer interested in locating a communications tower on county highway property, as the city zoning approval process takes too long. They're looking for lease space on an existing tower. With no further business, the meeting adjourned.
