Commissioner Chairman, Brian Haupert, called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. with all members present. Minutes of the 8/7 meeting were approved as written, moved by Lester Templin, second by Darle Dawes, and passed. Commissioners reviewed the Jail/Memorial Hall custodian hours. They heard a complaint from J.D. Miller about the chip & seal work done on old 24 W. He says too much stone was used. Les moved to approve Resolution 3, 2000, second by Darle, and passed. It authorizes the filing of a grant application under Section 5311 of the Transportation Act. Upon the recommendation of highway supervisor, Larry Rice, Commissioners approved a GTE request to bury cable at 7795 W 100 S (Mid America Radio Group). After review, Commissioner Attorney, Tom Mattern, assured Brian and Darle the Affidavit submitted by Don Metz for their signatures, was okay, so they signed. The Affidavit pertains to RLG tax delinquent property, and is a step toward divesting the land to Wabash Valley Landfill. Les moved support of the Sheriff buying a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria to replace the car totaled in a collision with a city police vehicle, second by Darle, and passed. The city's insurance paid \$11,000., and Tim will need an additional \$10,000. He has a request in to the Council for their 8/22 meeting. Sheriff Roberts will look into the status of relocating a DNR tower, and let Commissioners know when it will be set up. The Sheriff also shared a letter sent to Council members by the county's fire chiefs. They're asking that an additional dispatcher be hired to cover the increased demand for emergency response. With no other business, the meeting adjourned.
