She had no prior knowledge of the additional charges, and questions if it's her responsibility to pay them.

Highway Dept., Phil Amones: Phil has a SPRINT request to bury cable on CR 600 E, south from CR 1000 S, for about 400 feet. Also a VERIZON request to bury cable along CR 1425 N west of St. Rd 13, for 2931 E 1425 N. Both look okay, and Commissioners signed them. With no further business, the meeting adjourned.
