Festivities will begin at 9:00 A.M. with a ribbon cutting and dedication, followed by an open house until 11:00. Dick Robertson, with Congdon Engineering, Indianapolis, introduced the company and asked Commissioners to keep them in mind for future projects.

Larry Rice, Co. Highway Dept.: Larry says 105.2 miles of chip and seal are completed, with about 13 more scheduled at this time. He'll then check his finances to learn if he can add a few more miles this year. The weather has been great for chip and seal. He says a SPRINT request to bury cable 3 ft. off the road's edge, 1752 ft. from CR 500 N, north to a new home on CR 100 E looks okay. Commissioners signed the request. Larry presented a release signed by him, for the Metro North Elementary School Sanitary Sewer Extension project, indicating acceptance of the work completed. MSD agrees to assume responsibility for any injury to property directly or indirectly caused by work on this project. With no further business, the meeting adjourned.
