Wabash County Auditor, Jane Ridgeway called the meeting to order with all members present. The first order of business was election of officers for the year 2005. Nominations were then opended for Vice Chairman and Les nominated Darle, seconded by Brian. Darle was elected by a 3 to 0 vote.

Minutes for the December 20th meeting were approved as written, moved by Brian, seconded by Darle.

Wabash County Sheriff, Leroy Striker, reported a jail population of 91 this morning. He also gave an update on the Community Corrections area project plans: with construction expected to begin on February 1 and be completed by March 31. Sheriff Striker also discussed the new laws effective 12/31/05 that establish a central dispatch and stated that he is working on a plan to have in place to comply with the new law.
