Wabash County Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, February 25, 2008 following the County Council meeting. Phil Amones, WC Highway Department Superintendent, reported:

- 2. As to Guard Rail repairs. Commissioners would like a total before moving forward.
- 3. Amones reviewed the INDOT National Bridge Inventory Letter with Commissioners.
