Wabash County Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, November 14, 2011. Chairman Scott E. Givens called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. with all members present: Givens, Barry J. Eppley, and Brian K. Haupert. The proceedings of the meeting were recorded by Auditor Jane Ridgeway. The minutes of the November 7, 2011 meeting were reviewed. Haupert made a motion to approve the minutes as written; his motion was seconded by Eppley and passed with a 3-0 vote.

John Martin, Highway Superintendent:

- 1. Presented a road cut request for a new field tile ¼ mile east of 650 E on 350 N. Martin stated all material will be supplied by the property owner who has also requested a waiver of the normal fee. Haupert made a motion to approve road cut and waiver of fee; his motion was seconded by Eppley and passed by a 3-0 vote
- 2. Presented a Transfer Request to go before Council totaling \$4,100 to cover the cost of fuel for the remainder of the year. Commissioners unanimously approved request to go before Council.

Bob Land, Wabash County Sheriff, presented a jail report for the week ending 11/13/11. The average daily population was 69.14; two (2) inmates are housed at the Miami County Jail.

Bob Brown, EMA and Central Dispatch Director, presented two (2) quotes for the roofing project on the old State Highway Building at 814 Manchester Avenue.

- 1. Curran Roofing Company Inc. Marion \$9,807
- 2. Five Star Commercial Roofing Inc. Hartford City \$5,775 County Attorney Downs noted Five Star's last bid lacked a valid performance bond. This was found to be the fault of the bond company not Five Star.

Haupert made a motion to approve Five Star Commercial Roofing Inc. totaling \$5,775; his motion was seconded by Eppley and passed by a 3-0 vote.

Mike Howard, County Planning Director: presented a proposed amendment to the Wabash County Zoning Ordinance concerning Wind Energy Conservation Systems in Wabash County. Howard stated three items have been changed:

- 1. Increased set-back
- 2. Added a clause to the application process application which could permit a six (6) month extension
- 3. Lowered permissible decibel rating on the unit or any part of the process. Attorney Downs stated he had two (2) questions: the six (6) month extension and attorney fee collections. Downs stated he would work with Howard to clarify these items.

Steve Downs, County Attorney, was present with no report.

Jim Dils, County Coordinator, was present with no report.

Jane Ridgeway, Wabash County Auditor:

- 1. Presented the Payroll Claims and Allowance Docket for Pay Period ended 11-12-11; this included the last vacation payment for retiring County Health Nurse Jane Skeans from the Rainy Day Fund. Commissioners unanimously approved.
- 2. Presented an official CEDIT Additional Appropriation Request to go to Council for \$2,500: To remove test wells in LaFontaine TIF area. Commissioners unanimously approved.
- 3. Presented a Commissioners General Fund Internal Transfer Request for \$10,000: For testing K-2 violations of County Ordinance 2010-85-06. Eppley made a motion to approve request; his motion was seconded by Haupert and passed by a 3-0 vote.
- 4. Presented a request from DNR for an Appointment to Wabash River Heritage Corridor Commission for 2012; and a Proposed Resolution Confirming Participation in the Wabash River Heritage Corridor Commission Commissioners will take under advisement.

The Commissioners extended their appreciation to recently retired Health Department Nurse Jane Skeans for her years of service to the county.
