

September 8, 2014

The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, September 8, 2014. Chairman Scott E. Givens called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with three members present: Givens, Brian K. Hauptert and Barry J. Eppley. The proceedings of the meeting were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Linda Conrad. The minutes of the September 2, 2014 meeting were reviewed. Eppley made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Hauptert seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

John Martin, County Highway Superintendent stated the Highway department has completed 53 miles of chip and seal.

Sheriff Bob Land, reported the Wabash County Jail currently has 87 inmates with 25 inmates at the Miami County Jail. Last week, there were 6 transports and 15 bookings. The peak population was 93.

Keith Walters, County EMA Director stated the EMA assisted with traffic control over the weekend for the storm which brought down some trees, two 5-K runs and the Roann Parade.

Steve Downs, County Attorney was present with no report.

Linda Conrad, Wabash County Auditor presented; the payroll claims and allowance docket for 9/02/2014.

Jack Krouse, Construction Control, Inc. presented a letter to the Commissioner's in regards to the jail storage expansion. Two quotes were received but more information is needed before the contract can be awarded. Krouse will return in a week with his recommendation.

With no other business to come before the Board of Commissioners the meeting was adjourned. The commissioners will meet on Monday, September 15, 2014 in the commissioners' room on the second floor of the Wabash County Courthouse.
