

September 8, 2015

The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Tuesday, September 8, 2015. Chairman Brian K. Hauptert called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with all commissioners present: Hauptert, Barry J. Eppley and Scott E. Givens. The proceedings were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Linda Conrad. The minutes of the August 31, 2015 meeting were reviewed. Eppley made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Givens seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

John Martin, Wabash County Highway Superintendent stated that 24 miles of chip and seal have been completed on the county roads.

Bob Land, Wabash County Sheriff reported that the Wabash County Jail currently has 87 inmates with 42 inmates housed at the Miami County Jail.

Mark Frantz, County Attorney representative was present with nothing to report.

Jeff Hobson, Community Corrections Director and Sarah Lochner, Chief Probation Officer presented a strategic plan of collaborated services for a grant application with Community Corrections, Probation and the County Courts. The group asked the commissioners to sign a letter of approval to submit with the grant. Givens made a motion to sign the approval letter. Eppley seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Jeff Hobson also presented the annual report for Community Corrections.

Linda Conrad, Wabash County Auditor presented the accounts payable claims and allowance docket for 9/8/2015 and the payroll claims and allowances for the pay period ending 8/29/2015.

With no other business to come before the Board of Commissioners the meeting was adjourned. The commissioners will next meet on Monday, September 14, 2015.
