The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, December 4, 2017. Chairman Scott E. Givens called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with all three commissioners present: Givens, Brian K. Haupert and Barry J. Eppley. The proceedings were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Marcie Shepherd. The minutes of the November 27, 2017 meeting were reviewed. Eppley made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Givens seconded the motion; it passed by a 2-0 vote. (Haupert abstained because he was not present at the previous meeting.)

John Martin, County Highway Superintendent was present with nothing to report.

Bob Land, Wabash County Sheriff reported that the Wabash County Jail is currently housing 85 inmates with 42 inmates at the Miami County Jail, 1 inmate at the Elkhart County Jail and 3 inmates at the Blackford County Jail.

Land also stated a new water heater has been installed at the jail but no invoice has been received.

Keith Walters, EMA Director was present with nothing to report.

Steve Downs, County Attorney was present with nothing to report.

Jim Dils, County Coordinator/HR Director was present with nothing to report.

Marcie Shepherd, Wabash County Auditor presented the accounts payable claims for docket ending 12/4/2017. The commissioners approved all claims.

Givens requested a motion to reappoint Michael Beauchamp to the Wabash River Heritage Corridor Commission along with Keith Poole and Steve Johnson as alternates. He also requested that Jen Rankin be appointed as a new alternate. Haupert made a motion to make the requested appointments to the commission. Eppley seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

The commissioners again discussed a proposed ordinance (November 13, 2017) to remove two stop signs on North Ogden Road at 200 W. Land stated he felt they should remain due to the proximity of the school and fire station. Eppley made a motion to deny the original request for removal of the stop signs. Haupert seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Kelly Schenkel, Wabash County Assessor addressed the 2018 Cyclical Re-Assessment bid (November 13, 2017) which still needs to be approved. She stated Downs had requested a change in the performance bond wording. That change has been completed and he has approved the wording. Haupert made a motion to approve the contract. Eppley seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

The meeting was held in recess until the advertised bid opening for the county highway department's annual bids for supplies, materials and equipment rental.

At 9:30 a.m. the meeting was reconvened. Eppley made a motion to close the bids. Haupert seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote. The following bids were received:
