January 31, 2022

The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, January 31, 2022. Commissioner Barry J. Eppley called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with all three commissioners present: Eppley, Jeff D. Dawes and Brian K. Haupert. The proceedings were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Marcie Shepherd. The minutes of the January 24, 2022 meeting were reviewed. Haupert made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Dawes seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Cole Wyatt, County Highway Superintendent, presented a contract with Pioneer Associates for Bridge 909, a small structure replacement (January 18, 2022), for \$439,948.35. Haupert made a motion to approve the contract. Dawes seconded the motion; it passed by 3-0 vote.

Ryan Baker, Wabash County Sheriff, stated the jail currently has 83 inmates with 19 additional being housed in the Miami County Jail, 15 in the Fulton County Jail and 31 in the Tipton County Jail. Last week there were 21 book-ins and 6 transports to other facilities. The peak population was 85. The total inmate count was 151.

Keith Walters, County EMA Director, was present with nothing to report.

Steve Downs, County Attorney, was present with nothing to report.

Jim Dils, County Coordinator/HR Director, was present with nothing to report.

Marcie Shepherd, Wabash County Auditor presented:

- 1. Payroll claims and allowances for pay period ending 1/22/2022.
- 2. Draw # 5 of the BAN for \$990,000.

Haupert made a motion to approve the payroll claims and BAN draw #5. Dawes seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Eppley requested approval for A to Z Engineering to prepare a drainage report and driveway permit for the SR 13 property at the new jail site. Total cost of the project is \$3,500. Dawes made a motion to approve the contract. Haupert seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Eppley asked if there were any ADA or Title VI concerns. None were heard.

With no other public comment or other business to come before the Board of Commissioners, the meeting was adjourned. The commissioners will next meet on Monday, February 7, 2022.
