The Wabash County Board of Commissioners met in regular session in the Wabash County Courthouse on Monday, July 25, 2022. Commissioner Barry J. Eppley called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with all three commissioners present: Eppley, Jeff D. Dawes, and Brian K. Haupert. The proceedings were recorded by Wabash County Auditor Marcie Shepherd. The minutes of the July 18, 2022 meeting were reviewed. Dawes made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Haupert seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Ryan Baker, Wabash County Sheriff, stated that the jail currently has 86 inmates with 42 additional being housed in the Miami County jail, 12 in the Fulton County jail, and 26 in the Tipton County jail. Last week there were 21 book-ins and 7 transports to other facilities. The peak population was 94. The total inmate count was 167.

Marcie Shepherd, Wabash County Auditor, presented the accounts payable claims and allowances for docket ending 7/25/2022. Haupert made a motion to approve the claims and allowances as presented. Dawes seconded the motion; it passed by a 3-0 vote.

Eppley asked if there were any ADA or Title VI concerns. None were heard.

With no other public comment or other business to come before the Board of Commissioners, the meeting was adjourned. The commissioners will next meet on Monday, August 1, 2022.
